Cahokia Mounds

RTM was pleased to be able to travel to the ancient city of Cahokia in Collinsville, Illinois. Joe Harper was able to film the ancient site, including the massive mounds found at the site. Mainstream archeologists claim that the city was built by the Mississippian culture and was at its peak around 1100 A.D. The city was believed to have had a population between 10,000 to 15,000 people, rivaling medieval London that existed at the same. What mainstream archeologists fail to recognize is that the mounds found at the Cahokia site could be connected to the ancient giants of North America. The mounds at Cahokia are identical to mounds built across the North American continent. Giant skeletons have been found in many of these mounds, although this knowledge has been covered up today by institutions such as the Smithsonian. The largest mound found at Cahokia is Monks Mound, which is the largest pre-Columbian earthen structure in North America.

The mound is a pyramid reminiscent to other pyramids found in the Americas. The video from our expedition is available to watch on our YouTube channel.

RTM Confession of Faith Update

In our fall 2025 newsletter, we announced the writing of our RTM Confession of Faith. We are now pleased to announce that Joe Harper has made a few additions to the Confession to further reflect the theology that is the foundation of this ministry. Two paragraphs have been added to the Confession on the Nephilim and the Divine Council. Article 5 describes the Scriptural reality of the Divine Council and reflects the theology of Michael Heiser, who made significant contributions to this theology. Article 7 describes how angels called the Watchers descended down to the earth and took human women as their wives. The Watchers and their wives produced children called the Nephilim. The Nephilim were the giants that existed until the time of the great flood of Noah. Giants also appear after the flood as well. The rest of the Confession of Faith is unaltered except for a minor rewording of Article 11 on the gospel to provide greater clarity on this subject. The Confession of Faith remains Particular Baptist in its theology. The Confession is available to read on the RTM website.
